#### MEETING WITH OFFICIALS, INSTRUCTORS & COACHES:

There will be a meeting for all Officials, Instructors, and Coaches at 8:00am to 8:30am on both days. This is to discuss all appropriate matters to do with the tournament, ensuring it runs as smoothly and professionally as possible.

#### DIVISIONS:

All divisions will be split into a combination of gender, age, grade/rank, weight and height groups. (All divisions are subject to change without notice)

#### KYU/DAN SYSTEM & DIVISION - GUIDE: Please use the following guide when filling out entry forms.

[White Belt/10<sup>th</sup> Kyu-5<sup>th</sup> Kyu = 0-24 months training] [4<sup>th</sup> Kyu-1<sup>st</sup> Kyu = 24-48 months training] [Dan/Black Belt = Over 4yrs training] [Peewees = 4-7 years] [Junior = 8-11 years] [Intermediate = 12-14 years] [Colt = 15-17 years] [Senior = 18-39 years] [Veteran = 40 yrs+]

#### KATA SECTION:

Kata will be judged on: Technique - Stances - Balance - Speed - Power - Timing - Focus and Kata choice

<u>Team Kata:</u> Teams must contain a minimum of 3 members and can have a maximum of 5 members. One team per division per Dojo. <u>Weapons Kata:</u> In the situation of a draw you will need to perform a second Kata or you will be penalised. (*This does not apply to Junior competitors*).

#### FULL-CONTACT SECTION: To help save the planet you can access a full copy of the rules by visiting www.davieskarate.com

To create an even tournament as possible age group, weight and height will be matched as close as possible for the first round. Then each fighter will fight their way to the finals.

#### PRIZE GIVING AWARDS:

Prize Giving will be held at the end of each section i.e. Kata Section, Non-Contact Section, and Full-Contact Section. All place getters will need to be in Dogi/uniform to receive award. All competitors will receive a participation certificate. People who place 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> will be issued placement certificates; and all 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place getters will receive a trophy.

#### INJURY PREVENTION:

It is required that all non-contact and full-contact competitors wear 'Approved Safety Equipment'. Inspections will be held during the tournament and failure to comply will result in automatic disqualification.

Peewees, Juniors, Intermediates and Colts: (Compulsory) Head gear, Mouth guard, Shin & instep pads, Hand pads.

Male: (Compulsory) Groin Guard.

Female: (Compulsory) Breast Protectors; only approved KKNZ breast protectors.

Non-Contact Divisions: Senior competitors are required to wear appropriate hand pads.

Full-Contact Divisions: Senior competitors are not required to wear hand pads or shin & instep pads.

#### MEDICAL TREATMENT:

A St Johns medical team will be present to offer medical treatment. A Doctor will be present during full-contact section.
